You are hereby notified that pursuant to 12 O.S. § 2004.1(C)(2)(a), you are not required to appear in person at the place of production. You may produce copies of the documents requested by first class mail on the date of production. Failure by any person without adequate excuse to obey a subpoena served upon him may be deemed in contempt of the court from which the subpoena was issued. 12 O.S. § 2004.1(E).

In order to allow objections to the production of documents and things to be filed, you should not produce them until the date specified in this subpoena, and if an objection is filed, until the court rules on the objection. 12 O.S. § 2004.1(B)(1).

For your information, and assurance, this subpoena duces tecum is HIPAA compliant. Law Firm, as counsel of record for Party, has made a good faith effort to provide written notice to the patient, ____, through his attorneys of record, ____, that this information is being sought. A copy of this subpoena duces tecum has been provided to ____ identified above.
